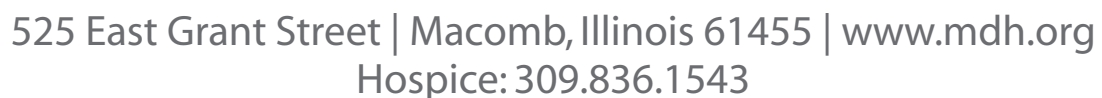

Frequently Asked Questions About Hospice

Are hospice admissions accepted seven days a week?

YES: Patient admissions are accepted after hours and on weekends.

Is there a better time to start hospice care?

YES: We encourage people to consider hospice care sooner rather than later. We help monitor changes and reduce chances of emergency needs through early symptom control.

Are people able to keep their physician?

YES: Hospice works with your family physician as well as the hospice medical director.

Are patients able to leave their home while in hospice?

YES: Hospice patients are encouraged to do the things they feel like doing.

Can hospice care be provided in other places than the patient's home?

YES: Many patients are able to remain at home or in the home of a family member, and hospice care may be provided in a nursing home, an assisted living facility, or a supportive living facility as well.
