

Changing Your Tax Withholdings

Now that tax season is among us, you may want to adjust your tax withholdings or change tax exemptions. To make these changes, complete a Federal and/or Illinois W-4 form and submit to Human Resources.

An alternative way to reduce your taxable income is by increasing your pre-tax pension contribution. Your retirement contributions can be deducted from your paycheck on a pre-tax basis for federal and state withholdings.

Get Your Free Colorectal Cancer Kit!

In recognition of Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month, MDH is providing FREE Hemoccult-ICT test kits. These test kits are the first step in detecting colorectal cancer.

The Hemoccult-ICT is a screening, not a diagnosis for colorectal cancer. Those who are age 45 or older, or are at higher risk because of personal or family history of colorectal cancer or colon polyps, should consider this screening.


