## Annual Wellness Visits



#### At McDonough Medical Group, we want to ensure that you have all of the necessary resources to manage your health.

Simply call your primary care provider and tell them you want to schedule your *Medicare Annual Wellness visit*. If you are new to Medicare, you can schedule your "Welcome to Medicare" exam during your first year of eligibility.
